- **OBJECTIVES:** The objective of the course is to introduce career and market oriented, skill enhancing "Add-on-course" that have the utility for job, self-employment and empowerment of students. After completion of the course the students will be equipped with an additional Add-on Course certificate and will be able to earn by preparing herbal products and daily usable commodities. They will also be able to join any herbal product manufacturing company with the knowledge from both traditional as well as modern approaches. They can also participate in the conservation programmes as well as propagation of selected indigenous medicinal plants for industrial use.
