Serampore College Sports News 2023

Serampore College has a well-established reputation in the field of Sports and Games and is the only one am0ongst the other colleges under Calcutta University, which has continuity in various sports. Serampore College has kept its position 1st to 2nd place in the preceding years in most of the events of games and sports.

Athletics

Serampore College Annual Athletics Sports Meet 2022-2023 was held on 17th of March, 2023 in the College Ground. 175 students' (59 Men, 38 Women, 25 Professors and 50 Non-Teaching) Took Participation in This Event. In the beginning of the day with Professor Souvik Dasgupta leading the way the students from the N.C.C. Department of the College conducted a March-Past. Principal and CEO Dr. Vansanglura and Vice-Principal and Games In-charge Dr. Bidyut Banerjee received the greetings and after that along with Principal hoisted the College Flag. Principal of the College in the meet.

With 45 points the 5th Semester Arts Students became the Class Champion. In the Men's category Sri Sayan Das (3rd Semester, B. Com Section) achieved the greatest number of individual points (25) and five gold medals (First in 110 m Hurdles - timing 17.0 sec., 100 m run – timing 11.7 sec., 200 m run – timing 25.3 sec., Long Jump – distance 5.71 m, Triple Jump – distance 11.76 m).

In Women's category Ms. Isha Santra (1st Semester, Arts Section) achieved highest individual points (13) with two gold and a bronze medal (Gold in 200 m run – timing 29.5 sec., Long Jump – distance 4.68 m and silver in 100 m run – timing 14.0 sec.)

In the events arranged for the Professors – in 100 m run Souvik Dasgupta (Bengali Dept.) came first with Debnath Pal (Sanskrit Dept.) and Anadi Roy Chowdhury (Physiology Dept.) respectively acquiring the second and third spot. In Hitting the wicket Dr. Kousik Pal (Physic Dept.) came first, Debnath Pal (Sanskrit Dept.) came second and Dr. Anupam Bandyapadhyay (Physiology Dept.) came third.

In the Staff above 50 years of age category, in the 200 m Walking event Tarun Kumar Samanta (Chemistry Dept.) won the 1st place, Mr. Abhijit Sengupta (Library) came 2nd and Mr. Pradip Kumar Mondal (Physiology Dept.) came 3rd.

In the events for Non-Teaching Staff in 100 m run Mr. Santosh Pradhan (Garden) won the 1^{st} place, Milon Rout (Office) and Mr. Susanta Paul (Physiology Dept.) respectively achieved 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place. In Hitting the Wicket (Men) Mr. Susanta Paul (Physiology Dept.) came 1^{st} with Mr. Devid Behara (Theology) and Mr. Abhimanyu Jenna (Chemistry) getting 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} spot respectively.

In Hitting the Wicket (Women) Ms. Sangita Sett (Principal Secretary), Ms. Arpita Das Roy (Office) and Ms. Sucharita Behara (Office) got the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place respectively. In the event Musical Ball for Staff members Mr. Sujit Bhar (Office), Mr. Jaydeb Mallick (Office) and Mr. Amit Kumar Das (Head Clack) secured 1st, 2nd, and 3rd position respectively.

In the event Musical Ball for Volunteers, Mr. Kaushik Das secured the first positions followed by Mr. Deep Ghosh secured the second position and Sk. Md. Junayed secured the third position.

In the event, Tug of War first position was secured by Students' team and the second position was secured by Non-Teaching staff members.





Teachers from different Departments gave away trophies to whoever secured first runner-up, second runner-up and third runner-up position Dr. Vansanglura, the Principal and CEO of Serampore College and Dr. Bidyut Banerjee, the Vice-Principal (ASC) and Games In-charge of Serampore College gave away the trophies to the students who became champion in the individual events. At last the Vice-Principal (ASC) lowered the College Flag and called it a day.

Games and Sports Seminar

Serampore College Games and Sports Department organized a Seminar on 20th March (Monday) 2023 at 11:00 a.m. at Carey Library & Research Centre (CLRC) Hall for the felicitation of the players of Serampore College 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022 years. The subject of Seminar was "Calorie Restrictions and Exercise-An Approach for Better Living". The Speaker of the Seminar was the Dr. Anupam Bandyopadhyay, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology (UG & PG), In-charge of Sports & Exercise Physiology and Special Paper of Post Graduate Course in Human Physiology, Serampore College. Principal rewarded Jacket to those 100 players. The whole programme was conducted by Ms. Sucharita Behara. Mr. Pranab Pal, Department of Games & Sports thanked everyone and hence, ended the programme.

206th Foundation Day of Serampore College

206th Foundation Day of Serampore College was celebrated on 15th July, 2023 in the CLRC Hall. The programme started at 10:45 a.m. with garlanding the busts of William Carey, Joshua Marshman and William Ward. In the first session, Principal Dr. Vansanglura delivered his speech and after that Rev. Dr. Dipankar Halder, the professor of Theology department offered prayer. In the second session, Dr. Prabhakar Bhattacharyya, professor of Philosophy, who was the chief speaker of the programme, delivered his speech on the theme "Development of Serampore College from 1818 to 1918". In the third session, at 12:30p.m. there was a cultural programme hosted by the students of Theology and the students of Arts, Science and Commerce. In the fourth session. at 3pm, a friendly football match was organised between the students of Theology and the students of ASC. In this match, students of ASC defeated the students of Theology by 2-0. Sakil Ahmed, a student of Arts dept. scored the first goal of the match in the first half and in the second half, Subham Mukherjee scored another goal on behalf of ASC team.

Rev. Dr. William Carrey's 262nd Birth anniversary

The birth anniversary of William Carey, founder of a 205-year-old institution, Serampore college was celebrated on Thursday 17th of August, 2023 with great enthusiasm. The procession was organised at about 7 a.m. from the college gate and moved towards the Carey cemetery for garlanding. Carey Memorial Service was also organised; followed by Tree plantation at 9 a.m. At 10:30 a.m. a seminar was held at the Carey Library and Research Centre along with the Prize Distribution Ceremony. The speech by respected Principal Dr. Vansanglura was followed by a prayer





by Secretary of the Theology Dept. Rev. Lalhritkima. The next speech was delivered by the chief speaker of the seminar, Rev. Dr. Dipankar Halder. It was an elaborate speech about the glorious days of Serampore College.

At 11:45 a.m., the students of all the streams who excelled well in the examinations, were awarded with scholarships from Denmark. In addition, o this, the toppers of all streams were honoured by Ms. Shalini Rightman, representative of the Consul General Office, Denmark.

The Principal and the Vice Principals of Theology and ASC Departments awarded the winners and runners up of the Drawing Competition which was held under the theme "William Carey". The participants of the drawing competition were students and wards of the staff members of the college.

At 2:30p.m., a Cultural Programme was organised where the students of Theology and ASC Dept. had participated. After that, an invitational Football Final match was held at 4p.m. Prior to this, two semi-final matches were held. In the first round, the second team of Theology and The ASC Dept. were the contestants. The ASC Dept. qualified for the finals, and the goals scored by Srinjoy Banik of 2nd year Arts and Debashish Jena of 4th year Arts students. In the following match, the contestants were the team of the college staff and the first team of the ASC Dept. The exciting match ended with the first team of the ASC Dept. standing as the winners on defeating the staff team with 1 - 0. The goal was scored by Sayan Khan who is a student of 6th semester.

Prior to the commencement of the final match Dr. Vansanglura met the players of both the participating teams. In the nail-biting match, no team scored a goal in 120 minutes. Inter-Departmental T20 Cricket Tournament 2023-24, was organised by Department of Sports, Serampore College, Serampore college ground. Ten departments including college staff and Theology department participated in this tournament. It was held on 29th, 30th November, 1st, 2nd and 6th December, 2023 (final).

On 29th November two matches were held. The first match was played between 3rd semester Science students and B.Voc students. In this match Science department batted first and scored 256 runs losing 6 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorers were Mr. Sagar Haldar who scored 54 runs and Mr. Sayandeep Mukhjerjee who scored 36 runs. In reply, B.Voc team scored 161 runs losing all wickets. Top scorer was Mr. Debasis Jena who scored 54 runs. Hence, 3rd semester Science students team became winner by 95 runs.

On the same day, in the next match Theology department played with 5th semester Science department. In this match, Theology department batted first and scored 203 runs losing 7 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorer was Mr. Rajesh MP who scored 47 runs. In reply, 5th semester Science team





scored 99 runs losing all wickets. Top scorer was Mr. Tushar Karmakar who scored 49 runs. Hence, Theology department team became winner by 104 runs.

On 30th November two matches were held. The first match was played between 1st semester Arts department and 1st semester Commerce department. In this match, Arts department batted first and scored 204 runs losing 7 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorers were Mr. Rohan Das who scored 64 runs, Mr. Ankit Yadav who scored 52 runs and Mr. Imran Nazir who scored 39 runs. In reply, Commerce team were all out in 44 runs in 10 overs and lost the match by 160 runs.

On the same day, in the quarter final match staff team played with 3rd semester Science department. In this match, after winning the toss staff team sent Science department to bat first and scored 138 runs losing 8 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorer was Mr. Ritam Gangopadhyay who scored 27 runs. In reply, the staff team scored 140 runs losing 3 wickets in 13 overs. Top scorers were Mr. Manoj Kumar Pradhan who scored 35 runs, Dr. Mridul Das who scored 29 runs and Mr. Souvik Dasgupta scored 28 runs not out and won by 7 wickets.

On 1st December, two matches were held. The first match was played between 5th semester Commerce Department and 3rd semester Arts Department. In this match, Arts Department batted first and scored 43 runs losing all wickets in 10 overs. In reply, Commerce Department scored the required runs without losing any wicket and won the match by 10 wickets. Top scorer was Mr. Mohammad Aftab who scored 28 runs.

On the same day, in the quarter final match, the Theology Department played with the 3rd Semester Commerce Department. In this match, Theology Department batted first and scored 179 runs, losing all wickets in 20 overs. Top scorer was Y Nirmal Kumar who scored 39 runs and John Cheriyan who scored 29 runs. In reply, the Commerce Department scored 73 runs losing all their wickets in 13 overs and lost the match by 106 runs. Top scorer was Mr. Swarnabha Banerjee who scored 16 runs.

On 2nd December, two semi-finals were held. In the first match, 5th semester of Commerce Department won the toss against Theology Department and chose to field first. Theology Department scored 170 runs, losing 8 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorer Ranpal Chandra Kumar scored 40 runs. In reply, Commerce Department scored 92 runs losing all wickets in 18 overs and lost the match by 78 runs. The top scorer Mr. Abhradeep Bhattacharyya scored 42 runs.

On the same day, in the second semi-final match, the staff team after losing the toss went to bowl against the 1st semester Arts Department. The Arts Department scored 173 runs losing all wickets in 20 overs. The top scorers were Mr. Rohan Das who scored 46 runs and Mr. Soumyajit Dutta who scored 28 runs. In reply, the staff team scored 179 runs losing 5 wickets in 18 overs and won by 5 wickets. Top scorers were Mr. Manoj Kumar Pradhan who scored 82 runs and Prof. Anirban Guha Thakurata who scored 23 runs.

On 6th December, a thrilling final was held. Before the beginning of the match, the principal and CEO Dr. Vansanglura of Serampore College was introduced to the players of staff team and Theology Department. The toss was conducted by the Principal with the captains of both the team. The captain of the staff team prof. Anirban Guha Thakurata, after winning the toss asked the Theology Department to bat first. Theology Department scored 125 runs after losing 9 wickets in 20 overs. Top scorer was Y Nirmal Kumar who scored 44 runs and amongst the staff team players Mr.





Pralhad Pradhan got 3 wickets, Dr. Mridul Das and Prof. Souvik Dasgupta bagged 2 wickets each, Prof. Anirban Guha Thakurata and Mr. Santosh Pradhan got 1 wicket each. In reply, staff team scored 126 runs losing 2 wickets in 16 overs and became the winner by 8 wickets. Hence, the staff team became the champion. TRIUMPHS OF SERAMPORE COLLEGE IN ATHLETES

The Inter college athletics championship 2023-24, organised by the sports board of Calcutta University, took place at Sai Complex, Salt Lake, on 18th and 19th December 2023. In this tournament, 144 male and 135 female students participated from 44 colleges. In the championship, 12 male and 12 female students represented Serampore College in various events.

The girls from Serampore College scored 42 points and won the championship, defeating S.I.P.E FOR WOMEN, Kolkata (scored 41 points) by 1 point. Kolkata Charuchandra College scored 32 points secured third place in the championship.

In the male group Charuchandra College, Kolkata scored 60 points and became the champion and Serampore College scored 45 points and became the runners up. Dhrubachaand Haldar College, Barasaat scored 22 points and secured third position.

Mr. Pranab Pal from sports department of Serampore College informed that the female students won seven golds, one silver and four bronze medals and the male students won two golds, six silver and two bronze medals.

Among the female students, the students of Arts Department, Isha Santra of Sem 3 won the first position in 100m huddles, high jump, long jump and 4x100m relay and secured the third position in 800m run. Debopriya Sarkar of Sem 1 secured a second position in long jump and came first in the relay race. Sayantika Naskar of Sem 3 secured a third position in 100m huddles and 100m run and also got the first position in 4x100m relay. Sangeeta Saha of Sem 3, secured the third position in 1500m run. Mampi Mondal of Sem1 secured the first position in 4x100m relay race.

On the other hand, the boys of arts department Anirban Mandal of sem 5 secured the first position in 110m and 400m huddles and also secured second position in 4x 100 m relay. Ranjan Majumdar got the first position in 1500m, 5000m and 4x 100 m. He secured the second position 4x 100 m run. He became third in 800m run. The students of Commerce department Sayan Das sem 5 secured the second place in 110m huddles and 4x 100 relay race and Soumayadip Bag of sem 1 secured the second place in 4x 100 m relay and also became third in 400m run.
